The Society of Cosmetic Chemists' Madam C.J. Walker Scholarship, generously sponsored by Mary Kay, signifies SCC's support of under-represented minorities (Black/Brown/African American, Native/American Indian/Indigenous Peoples, or Hispanic/Latin American) of any gender identity pursuing higher education in STEM disciplines related to the cosmetics and personal care industry.



Madam C.J. Walker (born Sarah Breedlove; 1867-1919) was an American entrepreneur, philanthropist, and political and social activist. She is regarded as the first female self-made millionaire in America. Walker made her fortune by developing and marketing a line of cosmetics and hair care products for black women through the business she founded, Madam C. J. Walker Manufacturing Company. At the time of her death, she had helped create the role of the 20th Century, self-made American businesswoman; established herself as a pioneer of the modern black haircare and cosmetics industry; and set standards in the African-American community for corporate and community giving. Two (2) scholarships, in the amount of \$5,000 USD each (sponsored by Mary Kay), will be awarded to two (2) underrepresented minority (Black/Brown/African American, Native/American Indian/Indigenous Peoples, or Hispanic/Latin American) applicants of any gender identity pursuing an undergraduate or post-graduate degree in chemical, physical, medical, pharmaceutical, biological, or related sciences and technology relative to the cosmetics and personal care industry.

The two (2) scholarship awardees will be invited to be recognized and accept a ceremonial scholarship check at the SCC Awards Breakfast on December 13th in New York City. In addition to the scholarship, SCC will provide each awardee with a \$350 travel voucher; two (2) nights complimentary accommodation at the Sheraton NY Times Square; a complimentary student poster at the Showcase; and a complimentary Full Access Registration to attend the SCC 77th Annual Meeting & Showcase in New York, NY, December 11-13, 2023.

Selected finalist(s) may be invited to be recognized at the SCC Awards Breakfast on December 13th in New York City. In addition to the invitation, selected finalists will receive a \$350 travel voucher; one (1) night complimentary accommodation at the Sheraton NY Times Square; a complimentary student poster at the Showcase; and a complimentary Full Access Registration to attend the SCC 77th Annual Meeting & Showcase in New York, NY, December 11-13, 2023.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee is generally comprised of up to five (5) SCC members appointed by President, the current President of the Society, plus Mary Kay representative(s), and any others as deemed appropriate, from time to time, by the Society's of Board of Directors.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION WINDOW & DEADLINE

The Application will open on Monday, April 3, 2023, and close on Friday, May 19, 2023. **Completed applications and all supporting materials requested, including transcripts sent from education institutions, must be received by 11:59pm EDT on Friday, May 19, 2023. Applications received after this date will not be eligible for consideration.** Ensure you provide a valid email address in your application; you will receive an auto-reply email confirming receipt of your application.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants:

- Must be currently enrolled full-time in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at an accredited college or university in the United States or Canada.
- may be of **any gender identity**.
- **Must be an under-represented minority, as defined** (Black/Brown/African American, Native/American Indian/Indigenous Peoples, or Hispanic/Latin American).
- **Must be pursuing an undergraduate or post-graduate Degree** in one of the following majors: chemical, physical, medical, pharmaceutical, biological, or related sciences and technology relative to the cosmetics and personal care industry.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants shall provide completed information as follows for consideration; incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

- 1. Completed online application, including:
 - a. Description of how you embody the spirit and legacy of Madam C.J. Walker
 - b. Statement of your accomplishments and your career goals/professional development plan
 - c. Description of your aspirations and potential impact to the cosmetics and personal care industry
 - d. Personal statement describing why you are deserving of the scholarship and how it will help you achieve your goals
 - 2. The following should be provided via email to jlewis@scconline.org:
 - a. Applicant's official current transcript with GPA (ensure you provide sufficient time for your academic institution to meet the submission deadline)
 - b. **Two letters of recommendation** from an Academic Advisor, Research Coordinator, Professor, Academic Success Coach, Mentor, or current SCC member (*each letter may not exceed 2 pages in length*)

SELECTION OF AWARDEES, FINALISTS, AND DECISION

Scholarship awardees and finalists will be chosen by the Madam C.J. Walker Scholarship Selection Committee based on the information submitted. The Selection Committee's decision is final.

INFORMATION VERIFICATION

The Selection Committee reserves the right to verify the accuracy of any information received or obtained related to a particular applicant; by submitting an application, you are giving the Selection Committee permission to do so.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDEE NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision on or about August 1, 2023.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD/FUNDING DISBURSEMENT DETAILS

Each scholarship awardee will receive the \$5,000 USD in scholarship funds, generously sponsored by Mary Kay. **Scholarship funds will be available for disbursement on August 11, 2023, and are paid directly to the awardee's educational institution** and must be applied toward costs of tuition, research, books or other expenses appropriate to their undergraduate or graduate studies, at the discretion of their academic advisor.

ONE-TIME/NON-RENEWABLE SCHOLARSHIP

The Madam C.J. Walker Scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship. Awardees are excluded from applying for

Madam C.J. Walker scholarship funds in subsequent years.

SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST/INSTRUCTIONS

Application: A completed online application form with all required information, including:

Educational Background: A list of relevant information, in chronological order, with most current data first. Include the name(s) of the institution(s), highest degree(s) attained, and years of attendance.

Work or Volunteer Experience: A list of your work and/or volunteer experience.

Academic Achievements, Honors/Awards: A list of relevant academic and/or service awards.

Association Activities: A list that includes the national local, and/or school association or club name(s), date(s) of membership, and any office(s) held and/or committee(s) served on.

Personal Statements:

- a. Statement regarding how you embody the spirit and legacy of Madam C.J. Walker.
- b. Statement of your accomplishments and your career goals/professional development plan.
- c. Statement of your aspirations and potential impact to the cosmetics and personal care industry.
- d. Statement describing why you are deserving of the scholarship and how it will help you achieve your goals.

Official Transcript: An official copy of your current transcript from your education institution, with grade point average, must be received by 11:59pm EDT on 5/19/23. Transcripts should be sent electronically to jlewis@scconline.org.

Letters of Recommendation (2): Provide two (2) letters of recommendation from separate sources which include the referring individual's mailing address, telephone number, and a valid e-mail address. These recommendation letters should not exceed 2 pages and must be provided by an Academic Advisor, Research Coordinator, Professor, Academic Success Coach, Mentor, or current SCC member.
