After acceptance of abstracts by the Committee, all presenters will be required to submit preprints 12 weeks prior to presentation (minimum of 600 words, maximum of 2 pages, including figures). All presenters will be eligible for the Society of Cosmetic Chemists' Award sponsored by Rhodia Novicare, which is given for the Best Paper presented at the Society's Annual Meeting. The honorarium for this award is \$2,500. **Presenters are required to register for the Meeting.****

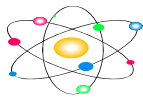
