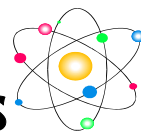
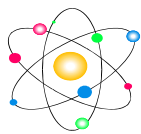

AFTER ACCEPTANCE OF ABSTRACTS BY THE COMMITTEE, ALL PRESENTERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PREPRINTS 12 WEEKS PRIOR TO PRESENTATION (MINIMUM OF 600 WORDS, MAXIMUM OF 2 PAGES, INCLUDING FIGURES). ALL PRESENTERS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SHAW MUDGE AWARD SPONSORED BY BASF CORPORATION, WHICH IS GIVEN FOR THE BEST PAPER PRESENTED AT THE SOCIETY'S ANNUAL SEMINAR.
