YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD, sponsored by <u>SCC</u>: Recognizing the Best Paper by a young scientist, under the age of 40, presented at the preceding SCC Annual Scientific Meeting, this award will be presented to **Jacob Sessions** (Überlube) for the SCC78 presentation, *Personal Lubricants are Medical Devices? - An Intimate Look at the Regulatory and Safety Challenges*.
