



GREEN STAR AWARD SUBMISSION FORM

Sponsored by Colonial Chemical, Inc., the Green Star Award is presented to the formulator who has done the most to accomplish green formulations during the past 12-month period.

The Green Star Award winner will receive a scroll, an honorarium and a complimentary SCC membership for One Full Year.

Procedure

1. To be considered for the Green Star Award, formulators must reply by **Friday, June 28, 2019**
2. The submission must be a commercialized product and must include the following:
 - a. Completed questionnaire (below)
 - b. Provide appropriately labeled documentation when requested
 - c. One (1) sample of the product in its commercial package
3. The completed submission should be sent to the SCC National Office, 14 Wall Street, Suite 1620, New York, NY 10005.
 - a. It will be reviewed by a committee who will make their determination based on the Green Star™ Rating, a classification system developed by industry professionals designed to allow the formulation chemist the ability to maximize the natural component in products. The higher the Green™ Star Rating, the 'greener' the product.
 - b. The award determination will also be governed by the committee's assessment of the products novelty as well as its level of innovation in formulation, and its creativity in fulfilling the marketing claims and providing efficacy with green ingredients.
